



CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Please review our camper Code of Conduct carefully.

Camp is to be a fun, safe place for EVERYONE, so it is important that all campers understand and follow the camp guidelines. Please review the following Code of Conduct expected and required at Camp Kagama.

1. Campers must have the desire to fully participate in the daily activities of camp.
2. Campers must stay safe while having fun. Always follow the directions of the Director, Staff and Counsellors and understand that the camp rules and guidelines are for the safety and protection of everyone at camp.
3. Respect other campers. (This includes no physical, verbal or mental abuse and bullying).
4. Obey all the rules of Camp Kagama.
5. Respect your environment and the camp campus by not littering.
6. **No** electronic gaming devices or any cellular devices (i.e: cell phones, iPads, iPods, MP3 players, etc.) are permitted at camp.
7. All campers' medications - both prescription and 'over the counter' medications - must be submitted into the possession of the First Aid Supervisor at registration. (Medications will be administered by this Supervisor as per directives on medical forms or instructions from parents.)
8. Do not abuse or deface camp facilities or equipment. (NOTE: Parents will be held financially responsible for any damages.)
9. Shoes must be worn at all times. Exceptions may be approved by Camp Counsellors on designated days.

If any camper behaves in any way which compromises our ability to foster enjoyment, a sense of respect and the dignity of EVERY person at camp (campers & staff alike), the camper will be subject to appropriate discipline as determined by the Camp Director and staff. The Camp Director also reserves the right to dismiss a camper who is a hazard to the safety and the well-being of any other campers.
